## 2012 Men's and Women's European Championships

On 28 February 2007, the European Handball Federation announced the 2012 Men's and Women's European Championships. The deadline for EHF Member Federations to register their interest with the EHF for the right to apply to stage one of both of the Championships was 10 April 2007.

The following nations have registered a letter of intent:

ECh for Men: 4 FRA, GER, GRE, SRB,

ECh for Women: 4 GER, NED, SRB, UKR

The nations listed above will now receive an EHF bid manual with the criteria of holding an EHF European Championship. They will then be requested to put their bid together and present it to the EHF by 1 October 2007. This will be followed by a process of evaluation, which includes site inspections. The events will be awarded at the EHF Congress on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2008.

2012 Men's European Championship: 17 to 29 January 2012 2012 Women's European Championship: 4 to 16 December 2012

19 to 31 January 2010 in Graz, Innsbruck, Linz, Salzburg, Wr. Neustadt, Wien

2010 Women's European Championship in Denmark/Norway:

7 to 19 December 2010
